- Problems with Laulima
 - If you change the course specifications in Banner, Laulima sometimes thinks it is a new course and the original course disappears, including grades. It happens periodically and randomly, not in every instance. There are no backups, no way to get the information back. This happened multiple times to him and others.
 - If it can't be fixed, then users should be warned. Announcements need to be sent out regularly.
 - There is about a half a dozen other problems with Laulima.

- Why can't a non-credit student get a UH ID?
