- Has there been a decision on providing reverse transfer for CTE degrees?
 Reverse transfer is for students who leave the campus without their degree.
 The student goes to a 4-year institution and takes courses that apply back to the community college for their degree. For many CTE courses, the only courses that would apply for reverse transfer would be general education courses. We would need to know if the numbers warrant going through the process.
- What is the campus doing to address being safe on campus? We are working
 with Cindy Melim to create a space to talk. We can also provide an
 information sharing time with HPD. Another possibility is to offer an active
 shooter drill in a building and invite anyone who would like to participate. It
 was requested that the drill be during the academic year so more people can
 participate.
- What are proactive ideas for improving the process when there is an incident? Can there be more preventative actions? Should we revisit our Emergency Plan? The advice from training is run, hide, fight. In an emergency call HPD, not security first.
- Could there be more ways to bring the campus together? A suggestion was made to have a social media site where employees can sell or exchange items. Sometimes employees feel disconnected. Can administration do more to say thank you to employees? Can there be an employee appreciation day? The Interim Chancellor will consider the suggestion.
