## PROGRAM DESCRIPTION/REQUIREMENTS

- Enrollment in a 1-credit course in Spring 2019 and again in Fall 2019 that includes communicating with student colleagues at **Kansai University, Takatsuki Campus Osaka, Japan** via technology
- Planning and leading a week-long visit of Japan student colleagues during Spring Break 2019
- Traveling to Japan in August 5-15, 2019 for a 10-day visit
- Completion of a collaborative group project to share with peers at both campuses.

## ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- ◆ Minimum 18 years old
- ◆ Kapi'olani CC student in Spring/ Fall 2019
- ◆ Available for Spring Break 2019 and travel in August 2019

- ◆ STEM or NREM pathway at KCC
- ◆ Sustainability Certificate pathway
- ◆ Completion of BIOL 124L (Environment and Ecology Lab)
- ◆ Strong interest in science, learning, and international exchange.
